Appendix: How is my water bill calculated?

The Double Horn Creek Water Supply Corp (DHCWSC) employs an industry-standard methodology to calculate monthly water bills. Monthly charges are determined based on the water usage recorded by the smart water meter installed at each residence, according to the rates and procedures outlined in DHCWSC tariff (See Appendix B of the Tariffs & Policies). Usage is measured by subtracting the previous month's billing cycle's final meter reading from the current month's end reading.

The foregoing table illustrates that the closing reading from the prior month's billing cycle is used as the opening reading for the current cycle. Consistent with established practices from traditional mechanical metering, public water utilities continue to calculate usage in units of "thousands of gallons." Therefore, for billing purposes, the data reflected in the table is converted to thousands of gallons, as shown below.

The rounding of usage figures to "thousands of gallons" may either increase or decrease the reported consumption, contingent upon the actual amount used (refer to the tables above for comparisons between actual usage and billed amounts). Monthly consumption is calculated based on the rate schedules specified in the approved DHCWSC tariff, and the resulting final bill is detailed in the table below.
